

ATRIAL FIBRILLATION STROKE RISK ASSESSMENT

- CHADS2VASc scores should be reassessed for every admission for patients in Atrial Fibrillation or have a known history of Atrial Fibrillation.**

Note: Many of you may not know that we are achieving accreditation for atrial fibrillation through the American College of Cardiology. One of the areas of opportunity is utilizing the CHADS2VASc scoring system. Regardless of known or new diagnosis, Atrial Fibrillation scores satisfy a requirement for Atrial Fibrillation Accredited Centers. Please continue to document this during each admission. CHADS2-VASc Score		
C	Congestive Heart Failure	1
H	Hypertension (>140/90mmHg)	1
A	Age >75	2
D	Diabetes Mellitus	1
S2	Prior TIA or Stroke	2
V	Vascular Disease	1
A	Age 65-74	1
Sc	Sex Category (Female=1pt)	1

Total Score		
SCORE	RISK	ANTICOAGULATION THERAPY
0(Male) or 1(Female)	Low	No Anticoagulation Therapy
1(Male)	Moderate	Oral anticoagulation should be considered
2 or greater	High	Oral anticoagulation is recommended
